INFORMATION FOR ALL TRIALS

DIRECTIONS:

FROM RINGGOLD I-75 exit 348: Take GA 151W 14 miles to GA 95, right onto 95, 2 miles to Cordell Rd. (Beagle Sign), left onto Cordell, ¼ mile to Beagle Club Rd. (dirt road on right) Approximately 30 minutes from I-75. – Approximately 30 minutes.

FROM RESACA I-75 exit 320: Take GA 136 22 miles to GA 151, right onto 151, 3 miles to GA 95 and follow above directions – Approximately 30 minutes.

FROM LAFAYETTE take US 27 N 5 miles to GA 95, right on to 95, go 4 miles to Cordell Rd. on right. Go ¼ mile to Beagle Club on the right.

FROM CHATTANOOGA via 124, exit 180b, Rossville exit: Take US 27 S 16 miles to GA 95, left on to 95 travel 4 miles to Cordell Rd. on the right.

FROM DALTON I-75, exits 333 and 336 Travel north on I-75 12 miles to exit 348 GA 151 in Ringgold and follow Ringgold directions.

TIMES AND MILEAGES ARE APPROXIMATE! If you use a map program, Catlett, GA is approximately 1 ½ mile east of Cordell Rd. on GA 95 at Dry Pond.

PLEASE NOTE: The grounds will be available for set up at 1:00 PM, March 24, and all set-ups must be removed by 6PM March 28, 2009, unless prior arrangements are made. Please keep your set-up clean; a trash dumpster will be provided; pick up after your dogs and do not leave trash on the grounds. **At all times gates must be closed and latched upon entering and leaving the field.** There will be practicing allowed Wednesday afternoon, Thursday, Friday and Saturday after the presentation of awards for a fee of \$5.00 per dog. Please check with Trial Chair for practice locations prior to going to the field with a dog. A handler will be allowed to take **only one dog in the field at a time, no exceptions.** There is a clubhouse on the grounds with restroom facilities. Roll call and meals will be held in the clubhouse. Please help us to keep the clubhouse clean by picking up after meals and while using the facilities.

FIELD TRIAL CLINIC: There will be an opportunity for individuals to learn about all aspects of Field Trials, including the release of their dog in the field on Thursday morning, March 25, 2009 at 11AM. If interested, contact Robert Schwalbe so time can be scheduled. There will be a \$5.00 fee for the use of the grounds for practice for each participant.

AKC SANCTIONED MATCH: There will be an AKC Sanctioned Match conducted by the Cumberland Valley Dachshund Club on Thursday, March 25, 2010 Role call will be at 3PM. There will only be Open Dogs and Bitches and will run as a combined class. Come support this Club. Contact Linda Cockburn for additional information at copia12345@yahoo.com or Janet Schwalbe.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per entry for regular classes all days. No charge for Best Open, Best of FC or Absolute Run. **Make checks payable to: Dachshund Club of Metropolitan Atlanta.** Be sure to bring your dogs' entry information with you. Dogs must be present on the grounds at the time entries close to be officially entered. Owner is responsible for correct information on the entry forms. Please note the divided FC classes and make proper notation on the entry form. You may copy the enclosed form if you need more forms.

RUNNING ORDER: Friday & Saturday classes will run concurrently with OAAD & FCD, followed by OAAB & FCB, then Best Open, Best Field Champion and Absolute. Sunday Classes will run concurrently with OAAB & FCB, followed by OAAD & FCD, then Best Open, Best Field Champion, and Absolute. Be prepared for this running order. Judges will not wait for dogs except as provided for in AKC rules. The committee reserves the right to make changes to the running order to expedite the event.

DRESS: It is recommended that sturdy shoes or boots and durable clothing be worn. Bring appropriate gear as the trial will be run rain or shine.

MEALS: Thursday night, pot luck: bring a dish to share if possible. Friday, Saturday and Sunday we will have breakfast and lunch prepared by culinary masters, Randy David, Will Guillot and Michael Pitisci. There will be a nominal fee, Breakfast \$5.00 and lunch \$6.00. Meals can be paid for at the trial but you **must RSVP by March 20, 2010 so meals can be planned accordingly.**
