Non-Regular Classes – Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs along with no fewer than two nor more than four of their GET. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. Get must be individually entered in one of the Breed Classes for which an entry fee is required.

Brood Bitch Class – For Brood Bitches along with no fewer than two nor more than four of their PRODUCE. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of Produce. Award will be based on the merits of the Produce. Produce must be individually entered in one of the Breed Classes for which an entry fee is required.

Since a judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to dogs and bitches 6 months and under 18 months. Veteran Sweepstakes is open to dogs and bitches 7 years and older. The entry fee is \$15. Each entry must also be entered in the Regular Classes at this show. Indicate Sweepstakes on the regular entry form in the space for Additional Classes. The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches (each Variety):

6 months & under 9 months of age – 9 months & under 12 months of age – 12 months & under 18 months of age.
 Veterans- 7 Years and older

NOTICE – Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 816-3776.

Novice Class – for boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class – for boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Be Sure All Information for Junior Classes is entered on the front & back of the entry form.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Show Site will be available at 7:00 AM the day of the show.
- Motor homes may arrive the Friday afternoon before show. \$25 a day. No hook-ups. First come, first served for parking places. There is no security guard. Neighborhood is safe and secluded from main streets. **Contact Robert Schwalbe for reservations**
- Grooming indoors.
- No unattended dogs in ex-pens on the grounds at any time.
- No merchandise other than authorized by the show committee may be sold on any part of the show site.

- Exhibitor parking will be designated. There will be a designated area outside the building for loading and unloading of dogs and equipment.

- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor the Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed, Variety, or Class judging.
- All Prizes must be claimed the day of the show(s). None will be mailed.
- Be advised, an Event Committee hearing will be convened to consider charges and discipline to persons failing to observe event guidelines, and/or verbally abusing show personnel. Failure to observe event guidelines could result in loss of AKC privileges.
- The Show Giving Club and the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This Recording Fee and Event Service Fee are collected by the Show-Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording and the Event Service Fees are collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11; Section 2). These AKC fees are included in the Entry Fees stated in this premium.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If, by conditions beyond the control of the Show giving Club, it is necessary to cancel or stop the Show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made. Due to expense of processing, refunds of \$4.00 or less will not be made.

Telephone, fax, or email entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and/or photocopies without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Entry Forms must be signed. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be reimbursed in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. A collection fee of \$15 will be added to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
